VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Good morning, I call this meeting of the Central Florida Tourism Oversight

District Board of Supervisors to order. Before we begin, I would like to introduce for our invocation Pastor Finoy Johnson, who will lead our invocation today. Pastor Finoy -- hopefully, I pronounced your name right -- was born in India, and has spent most of his life in the United States. He's a son of Pastor Johnson Zachariah and Sister Johnson who served the Church of God for 50 years.

Pastor Finoy completed his undergraduate studies and later earned a Masters in Theology and Biblical Studies. While living in Dallas, he was activity involved in the Dallas/Fort Worth Citywide Fellowship and Youth Fellowship, in addition to serving his local congregation.

In 2000, Pastor married Sister Suni, and they are blessed with three children: Alexander, Alyssa, and Andrew. The pastor and his wife -- they're entire family is involved in ministry where they do international missions and campus youth ministry. They've traveled to multiple countries with their international team leading biblical and medical

camps.

Pastor, would you please stand and lead us in prayer?

PASTOR JOHNSON: Good morning, it is a wonderful privilege for me to be here this morning. I appreciate the opportunity on behalf of IPC Orlando, where I serve as associate pastor, on behalf of our senior pastor, who is actually traveling on a mission opportunity, and the Board and the members, I extend our prayers of blessing to this body and to all the work that you do.

I just wanted to share a brief thought and lead us into prayer. One of the characters in the Bible that most people refer to is David. He's known for his musical abilities, being a good shepherd, but also as one who slayed the giant. But in the New Testament, when they talk about David, it says, David served the purpose of God in his generation.

I pray as his body that they would have that same mentality and mindset, that whatever God has fulfilled or asked for this body, to fulfill the purpose that we can serve the generation. And David did so by setting up the next generation for success, as well, and I pray that this body has the

wisdom to do that.

Let's pray. Almighty Holy Living God, through your only begotten Son, Jesus Christ, we come before your throne and call you Father. Thank you for the bountiful blessings you showered upon us. I pray that your wisdom, your guidance, your discernment is entrusted to this body as many decisions will be made in the coming days and weeks.

I pray that your favor will be upon every member and every decision that is made in the fear of God and for the welfare of the people. I pray that your presence would guide each member and their families. I pray that each of us may be faithful stewards of every responsibility and opportunity that has been relegated to us.

May our words and actions honor our creator,
Lord Jesus Christ. Our Heavenly Father, we also,
at this time, bless our state, our neighbors,
especially those who have been impacted by the
calamities. Lord Jesus, we pray that your hand
will be upon our nation in these critical times.

The Lord bless you and keep you. May the Lord make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you. The Lord lift up his countenance upon you and

give you peace. In the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, we pray, amen.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Amen. Thank you, Pastor.

PASTOR JOHNSON: Thank you.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: With that, please rise and join me in the pledge of appliance.

ATTENDEES: I pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of America, and to the Republic, for which it stands, one nation, under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Thank you. And, you know, with that -- I guess I didn't really greet everybody properly, but it's good to be back.

Yeah, nothing -- not like anything too exciting went on in the last month, so it's been a very quiet period of time. Hopefully, now that we're through the budget season, through hurricane season, we'll -- looking forward to getting -- looking forward and being, you know, productive and forward looking, and hopefully getting back to a little bit of normalcy.

And along those lines, before we get to our safety minute, I did want to pause and reflect for a moment on the devastating impact of our region -- on our region of two powerful storms: Hurricane

Helene and Hurricane Milton. It was an unprecedented one, two punch of flood and wind damage that impacted the state from the Gulf to the Atlantic and our District in between.

I wanted to take a moment to thank -- sorry, thank our District team members who manned our Emergency Operation Center, and those who responded after the storms to ensure that the District returned to normal operations swiftly and safely. You are the best of the best in public service today, and I'm proud to work with all of you.

I'd also like to thank all of those who live and work in the District, who showed up under very stressful circumstances, and helped so many visitors navigate the storms' uncertainty and safety and security. And I would add myself and my family among them.

For some of our guests, a hurricane just happened to land during the first and possibly only time they'd ever visit Walt Disney World. And so when you think about that, a swift return to normal operations help make sure that those folks from -- who came from all around the world, I spoke to folks from France, from Germany, and elsewhere, experience a trip of a lifetime with minimal

disruption and full safety. So everyone here can take great pride in that.

I'd like to give a few specific shout-outs.

So, yeah, as I said, my family and I, including a newborn, were fortunate to ride out the storm alongside many District employees at the Wyndham Lake Buena Vista next door. And along those lines, I'd like to thank Mr. Jay Leonard, the general manager of the Wyndham, for hosting me and my family and so many -- and dozens of District personnel.

I think everyone here knows Jay. He's a regular presence at our meetings. Someone introduced him to me as the mayor of Walt Disney World, and as best as I can tell, he's earned that title better than just about anyone else. Jay seemed to know -- I've never gotten to see him in his element like that before. He seemed to know all his guests personally and made sure their needs were attended to.

He told me Milton was his 17th storm at the hotel, and it showed. He and his team are a well-oiled machine, and they managed to turn what could have been a very stressful experience for a lot of guests into a positive one. In particular,

I have a seven year old and a five year old already asking when they -- when they can come back. So big thanks to Jay and his team at the Wyndham for -- for their support.

Secondly, as I was leaving the hotel to return home the day after the storm, I happened to run into Joey Rodriguez. I know Joey can't be here today, but he's, of course, our District Manager of Building and Safety. Joey gave me the good news that there were no -- there was no significant storm damage related to any structures within the District. Not every city or county in Florida can say the same.

I think that is a testament, at least in part, to the foresight and resiliency of the Epcot building code and the efforts of Eddie. His recent predecessors, Mike Rickabaugh, Jerry Wooldridge, and their entire department, as well as the quality and -- of construction and maintenance performed by the Walt Disney World team and other businesses operating the District. So I think it's worth recognizing that.

We are a best-in-class environment from top to bottom, and it's from -- part from the District, but it's also from all the folks, and, obviously,

Disney -- the Disney folks deserving a big part of that credit, as well. So I just salute all of you, and please keep up the good work, and thank you-all.

Finally, Stephanie, I'll just briefly say that I'm grateful for your calm and experienced presence at the helm of this operation, and thank you for steering the ship.

To all of those who the recent hurricanes have impacted, I hope you will please consider seeking out disaster assistance from the local, state, and federal agencies to ensure you and the communities -- and our communities can recover quickly, and our thoughts and prayers here at the District are with you.

So with that, we will hear from Eddie Fernandez, who will present our safety minute.

MR. FERNANDEZ: Thank you, Mr. Vice Chair, members of the Board, and to all of our guests and visitors, we like to cover some safety elements before every board meeting for your protection.

We want everyone to know that in the event of an evacuation, there are two exits. You can use the ones to the right, and those will lead you to the front of the building where you came in this morning. But if you exit through these on the left, these double doors on the left, that will take you to an exit at the rear of the building.

We ask everybody to make their way to the front and to the ends of the parking lot where our employees will be, and they will ask you to stay there until emergency services responds and tells us that we have the all clear to come back in the building.

In the event we need first-aid or AED, both of those are available at the security desk up front, and we will grab those if necessary.

To add to your message, Mr. Vice Chair, just a moment ago, in light of the recent hurricanes that impacted Florida, this month's safety tip, we want to underscore the importance of emergency preparedness. And although it's not possible to avoid the damage that hurricanes bring, we do have advanced notice that they're on their way to give us the opportunity to prepare as best that we can.

However, having this advanced notice

doesn't -- isn't always the case for other types of

emergencies: tornadoes, national emergencies, job

loss, sudden illness, fires, and a various -- a

variety of other unforeseen circumstances can

create significant challenges if we don't prepare properly.

As you'll hear from District Administrator,
Stephanie Kopelousos, in a moment, the District's
ability to formidability respond to Hurricane
Milton is attributable to the planning and efforts
of our employees and our leadership, our leadership
team. We are especially grateful to District
emergency manager, Tanya Naylor, and her team for
their hard work. They expertly managed a multitude
of tasks in preparedness and response efforts, and
the results speak for themselves. Thank you,
Tanya, and to all of our employees for their hard
work.

Since no one ever knows when the next emergency is going to take place, we strongly encourage everyone to take the necessary time to regularly build, test, and refresh your emergency plans and supplies. The State of Florida government website offers an excellent selection of online resources to help anyone get started. We're hopeful that everyone who was impacted by Hurricane Milton is recovering as quickly as possible and is back to some sense of normalcy right before we head into the holiday season. Thank you very much for

your time, enjoy the meeting.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Thank you, Eddie. Our next -- our next item is the public comment period. A general reminder this is a time for public comments, not a question-and-answer period for the Board. It's important for us to receive public comments to enact the will of the people of Florida. If you have -- if you wish to make a public comment, please state your name and address before addressing the Board. Now, I don't have any cards in front of me. Should I take that --

MS. KOPELOUSOS: No public comment.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: No public comment. All right. In that case, no one has signed up for public comment, so we will move on to the consent agenda items.

Today's consent agenda, that's item No. 6 on the agenda. Today's consent agenda has six items. Items 6.1, 6.2, and 6.3 cover the approval of the meeting minutes from the August 28th,

September 11th, and September 25th meetings,

respectably. Item No. 6.4 seeks the approval of a non-exclusive temporary easement with a permanent easement with Peoples Gas System, Inc, a/k/a TECO. Thanks, TECO, for getting my lights on this week,

by the way.

Item No. 6.5 covers the approval of a non-exclusive permanent easement with Summit Broadband, Inc., and item No. 6.6 covers the approval of the release of interest in the greenways and easements of the Lake Marion Preserve Property, Tract C, Poinciana Neighborhood 1 West, Village 7 Plats.

Finally, 6.7 -- item 6.7 on the agenda includes the 2023 District engineer's annual report, and the companion 2024 water control -- control structure inspection report.

I did think it would be appropriate and helpful for Katherine, the District's manager of planning and engineering, to comment on agenda item 6.6, which include -- involves the District's participation and effort by Polk County and the nature conservancy.

MS. LUETZOW: Good morning.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Good morning.

MS. LUETZOW: So as the Board may be aware, the District owns a two acre parcel of land in Polk County. This was previously purchased as part of our permitting for a prior roadway capital improvement project many years ago, and it's for

threatened and endangered species, primarily sand skinks at the time.

When the District purchased this property, because of the way the area was platted, we had interest in an adjacent property and common areas. This adjacent property is about 600 acres of land that was recently purchased by Polk County, and so Polk County reached out to District staff with a request for the District to release our interest in these common areas on this adjacent parcel.

And that is because Polk County and the nature conservancy are working together to do conservation over this area because, like our parcel, it has scrub habit, which is vital for certain species, including the Florida scrub-jay and sand skinks, its vital habitat.

And so District staff reviewed this request, and because it helps bolster our mitigation, which is right next door by providing a larger area of conservation, we are recommending to the Board that the District release this so that that effort can continue forward.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Very good. Thank you,

Katherine. I appreciate it, and I thought this was
a great example of partnering with neighboring

counties for sort of the greater good, and, obviously, conversation is a noble goal. Let the -- I hope the record will reflect, and history will reflect, that this District is a -- a true friend of the sand skink.

So, with that, is there a motion to approve today's consent agenda?

MR. AUNGST: So moved.

MS. ZIEGLER: Second.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: All those in favor, say aye.

THE BOARD: Aye.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Any opposed? Hearing none, let the record reflect that the consent agenda passes unanimously. Thank you.

Item -- agenda item 7.1, the management report. Topic, hurricane response. With that, I'd like to invite the District administrator, Stephanie Kopelousos, to deliver her report. Stephanie.

MS. KOPELOUSOS: Chairman, first of all, thank you for acknowledging the team. When you look at a hurricane coming our direction not knowing where it's going, you realize very quickly how prepared our district is, our team is, to respond. But not

just to respond, it's the preparation that goes ahead. Yes, we had a few trees down, but part of it is we maintained the structures, right? We maintained the -- the landscaping to make sure that those trees that are vulnerable, those have already been taken out in preparation for this. Those that we can save, they're saved.

And I think that helps with the recovery, but all that is part of what this team does day in and day out, in each and every day. And I know I've only been here a few short months, but you can see what a well-oiled machine this team is; not just in response and preparation for the storms, but when you look at everything else they do on a regular basis. And I am just grateful and humbled to watch this team operate.

And you look at the sacrifices they made, you look at -- for example, Tanya, and her team, they were in the EOC throughout the event leaning into it. And, yes, Tanya has a family plan for her family, but I think what's obvious in the team that rides this out, and the EOC, and our garage, it includes every aspect of our team.

I mean, we had IT in the EOC with us. But it's to make sure that we can respond to anything

and everything that happens. And you look at Tanya's leadership, but I look at the rest of the team who is a part of this response.

You look at the Chief and Roger and their whole team. I mean, not only are they responding to incidents that are happening, but as soon as that storm went through, we were out with the fire trucks, with chain saws cutting and tossing. And it wasn't just us, it was the Disney team. It didn't matter for the Disney team that it was our roadway. They got there before we did, they started going, we moved forward. Took -- you know, so it's the real team approach.

But you look at engineering and planning. You look at Katherine's team, and they rode it out. They were the first ones in. You look at the amount of water that was coming, and then you see Reams Road is under water right now, dealing with the county and those relationships and controlling that.

But you look at not just the roadways, but you look at the canal structures and what they were seeing, and you can't just get there immediately. We were seeing downed trees in the canals, and we were seeing blockages, and Katherine immediately

knew within hours something is between here and here because the water level has changed. I mean, she knows it like the back of her head. You know, numbers just appear, and she goes, It's this level here, this level here, something in the middle is the problem, we'll get there. But it's not the emergency right this second, here's what we're focused on.

So when you look at that, and I look at

Ella -- and I know Joey is not here, but, Ella,

y'all were here leading up to it, you helped. You

did everything you needed to do with inspections

and making sure that our partners could get up and
running.

But part of -- like what you said, Chairman, it's the work that's done beforehand. It's making sure we do it right from the beginning and making sure that we -- you know, I will tell you, Tallahassee called me three times, did the power go out? Did you lose any power? I'm like, No, we didn't lose power. We're not going to lose power. (indicating). Watch the electricity go out right now. That serves me right, Chris.

But those are the things, and you look at the teams who rode out the storm and -- and families

were not with them and making sure they have a plan. It's just -- it is humbling and rewarding all in the same that I have the opportunity to work with a team like this.

But it goes beyond -- I mean, our utility. I bet one county, one district cannot say we didn't lose electricity. Everything kept moving. They didn't -- and they rode it out in their EOC. Chris, your team, everyone was in. We were all talking, going back and forth, but nothing happened. Chris calls me and goes, We still have all electricity. I'm like, Thanks.

That just doesn't happen. That doesn't happen without having the best of the best, and I am grateful. Now, that doesn't mean that things didn't happen and we're not in the process of recovering. Katherine's team is out there each and every day still dealing with the level of water that we're dealing with. But it was our signals were askew, right, we have signs that were down, and those type of things that are easier than what could have -- could have been if we didn't plan appropriately.

And I just want y'all to hear me say this to this team, I'm grateful. Grateful to the work you

put in, but's it not just in these times, it's day-to-day. It's everything that happens. When you look at Douglas, your facilities team, they were right there with us. They made sure -- yeah, we had a few leaks, we had a little bit of water, but I don't know anyone with the amount of wind and water we had that didn't have some water and infrastructure that was affected. But -- but Douglas's team was here. They were with us the whole time. I mean, everyone was out as soon as daylight came driving around to see what was going on and what could be helpful.

I know I've left people out, but I can say
this: Every single part of our team chipped in to
make sure we got this right and -- and did things
right, and for that, I'm grateful.

Mr. Chairman, blessed to be here and excited to see the things that are coming.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Amen. Thank you,

Stephanie. Very well said. I can't -- can't echo
that -- all of those statements, echo and underline
them and co-sign them a thousand times over.

I mean, look, I'll just say: Tanya, Chief,
Katherine, Douglas, I should -- you know, I should
be thanking you-all at the start of every meeting,

and at the end of every meeting. Like I've said before, the degree -- the everyday degree of difficulty here and what you-all do is at the highest level. I would put it up against any city, county government, any fire department anywhere in the country. Okay. That's on -- that's on an average sunny day, not during hurricane season.

To add -- add this weather, add the tension, add the crowds, and to remain safe, to remain secure, to not have a significant disruption in power, a significant issue with any building, that's just -- it's a testament to the work that you-all have been putting in, not just -- as Stephanie said, not just during and leading immediately up to the storm, but in the weeks and months and years that you-all have put in here, so I can't thank you enough.

And, Stephanie, like I said, thank you. It's a -- you're -- you've mentioned a lot of names. You didn't mention yourself. You deserve a lot of credit, and I thank you. That's a testament to your self-less leadership, and we're glad to have you here, so thank you-all.

And now -- and, yeah, so I appreciate that.

Thank you for the report. And, Roy, I did want to

take a moment. I should have mentioned this earlier. I wanted to -- I spoke to you about this directly, but I wanted to mention it on the record, obviously acknowledge the passing of your mother-in-law and let you know, deliver the condolences of myself, I'm sure on behalf of the Board, on her passing, and we're glad to have you here, so thank you.

MR. PAYNE: Thank you.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: And we'll now move on to general business. We have five items to cover under general business. Agenda item 8.1,

Approve -- Approval of the establishment of an allowance for the procurement of owner-furnished materials necessary to provide electric service for Project L in the amount of \$4 million.

We will hear from Chris Ferraro, director of Reedy Creek Energy Services, who will present on all five items under the general business section of our meeting. And, Chris, great to have you back, and, again, thank -- yeah, thank you for keeping the lights on for us.

MS. FERRARO: Thank you. And as Stephanie said, credit to the team. We had a large ride-out crew, and there were no disruptions in any of the

utility systems for the District, so happy to serve to the District and the District's customers, and great to work with Stephanie. We talked -- and Tanya and the whole gang from the District. We talked multiple times throughout the event.

But I do have five agenda items this morning. Luckily, three of them are about electric, so this is going to be super fun, so here we go. So our first request is for a \$4 million equipment allowance to supply electric service to a new customer of the District. We received a utility service request --

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Chris, I'm sorry. I don't mean to interrupt. We -- our monitors are not on up front. Sorry.

MS. FERRARO: No problem.

MS. ZIEGLER: We have swivel chairs. We can swivel.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: I suppose we could.

Perfect. Thank you. Technical difficulties.

All right. We're back in business. Chris -- thank you, Ron. Carry on.

MS. FERRARO: No problem. So just a little bit of the "why" for this item. It is unusual for us to come this early in our design process for a

new customer to ask for an equipment allowance, but there are long lead times associated with the electrical equipment required for this system expansion to serve the customer.

So during the pandemic we had a disruption in a lot of areas, but in the supply chain that supports electric utility systems, particularly switch gear, high-voltage cable, medium-voltage cable, and transformers. And today that long lead time is still continuing.

There's an increased demand for this equipment. We have increasing electrification globally. We have large customers like data centers that are also utilizing this equipment, and then we just have replacing infrastructure, and, of course, the hurricanes that damage equipment also create the demand.

Lead times associated with the equipment we'll be purchasing with this allowance. We have electrical switch gear and 15,000-volt cable, that's more than a year. Standard voltage transformers are one to two years, and then if we need a non-standard voltage or a large power transformer, that we'll talk about in a future agenda item, that can be two years or more.

So we are asking for a Board consideration of a \$4 million allowance for owner-furnished materials, including cable, transformers, switches, and pertinent items so that we may issue purchase orders for this equipment when the design is finalized, and the design criteria for each of those items is available.

We are close on that design criteria, but we have not finalized that, but with the lead times we're requesting Board approval now so that we can get these items ordered and be able to extend the system as required.

I wanted to assure the Board that there are sufficient funds available in the utility division to support this request in advance of coming in for a full project budget. What you'll see in the graph on the right hand of the slide is a look at the utility's unrestricted reserve funds. We are forecasting a year-end balance of \$53.5 million in that reserve fund.

We have commitments, including our fiscal year 2026 60-day cash reserve subtracted from what is available in that 53.5 million, and we are showing a \$19 million available balance. We will go ahead and reserve that fund for any of the deposits or

cancellation fees that may be required for this equipment.

We do expect that this cash flow for this item, we won't receive them until 2026 or 2027, and you'll see the projects will come in front of the Board as we have a full project scope and we move through our engineering and design phase for these projects. Those items will come before the Board, likely financed through utility revenue bonds in '26 and '27.

That concludes agenda item 8.1.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Thank you, Chris. Any questions from the Board on this? The 4 million, Chris, I assume there's some comfort level.

That's -- I guess, there's some room in that number in case, I guess -- on the uncertainty. There's some uncertainty baked into that, I guess, but you're comfortable with that figure?

MS. FERRARO: We have gotten some quotes from vendors on equipment, and we've held about a 10 percent contingency in that \$4 million value. We do have some items in inventory, but these would be for what is newly required.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Okay. All right. That seems reasonable. Is there a motion to approve the

procurement of owner-furnished materials for Project L for 4 million?

MS. ZIEGLER: Yes, move approval of agenda item 8.1.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Second?

MR. AUNGST: Second.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: All those in favor, say age.

THE BOARD: Aye.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Any opposed? Hearing none, let the record reflect that the motion passes unanimously.

In agenda item 8.2, the District seeks to approve contract No. C006553 with McKim & Creed, Inc., for professional engineering services to make improvements to the condenser water and cooling tower systems at the Epcot Central Energy Plant in the amount of \$295,859 plus a 10 percent contingency for a total of \$325,444.90, plus an RCES design/support services fee not to exceed 75,000.

Chris, I understand this contract would allow for increased operational efficiency by not -- by allowing you to isolate a cooling tower should there be a need to create repairs. If you could maybe elaborate on that and then present the item.

MS. FERRARO: Thank you, Vice Chair. You have done a great job describing this item. I'll add very little to it. But at the District's Epcot Central Energy Plant, we do produce hot water and chilled water. It is a pretty significant production facility for chilled water. We have eight, 2,000-ton chillers, and there are four cooling towers. So each of the chillers, there's two chillers per cooling towers.

Three of the cooling towers were installed with the original plant construction in the early 1980s. The fourth cooling tower was installed in 1989. All of those cooling towers are collected in a common basin.

So this project envisions the ability to do a design and upgrade to be able to isolate each cooling tower, and to be able to isolate the condenser water basin so that we have operational flexibility, and we don't have to impact a large section of the production facility for that required maintenance activities. And you can see in the picture here we have one of the chillers inside the Epcot Central Energy Plant.

On the next slide, we have a picture for

everyone who wonders what a cooling tower looks like. So on the first picture, you can see a view of the Epcot Central Energy Plant. There are four large cooling towers that evaporate water, and that water is collected in a common condenser basin. So this project would install piping and other pertinent devices to allow us more flexibility in the maintenance of that basin.

We did go out with a Letter of Interest for this project, and we had three vendors who brought us proposals. McKim & Creed is the most qualified and selected vendor, so we're recommending, at this time, Board approval to McKim & Creed for professional engineering service for improvements to the Epcot Central Energy Plant condenser water and cooling tower systems in the amount of \$295,859, plus 10 percent contingency, and a total amount of \$325,444.90, and then a request for RCES design and support services fees for \$75,000 for the design and bidding phase. This project will be funded from cash on hand from the CFTOD Series 2021-2 utility revenue bond, which is one of our taxable borrowings.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Chris, we have a pretty long-standing relationship with McKim & Creed,

don't we?

MS. FERRARO: Yes, we do.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Great. Excellent.

Members, any questions for Chris?

Great. In that case, is there a motion to approve item No. 8.2?

MR. AUNGST: Move to approve item 8.2.

MS. ZIEGLER: Second.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Very good. All those in favor, say aye.

THE BOARD: Aye.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Any opposed? Hearing none, let the record reflect that the motion passes unanimously.

Item No. 8.3 on the agenda, The District seeks the approval of contract No. C006528 with Chen Moore and Associates for professional engineering to replace the potential load-break switches and unit substation transformers at Epcot in the amount of \$570,335.10. Item 8.3 also includes a 10 percent contingency for a total of \$627,368.61, plus an RCES design/support services fee not to exceed \$200,000. Chris, why don't you go ahead and cover item 8.3?

MS. FERRARO: Certainly. So, in this item, we

are seeking to focus on these switches that are located around the Epcot electric distribution system for the District. It's a 12,000-volt piece of switch gear, and you can see it is vintage in the picture. We have -- the switch is located on the left-hand side, and the transformer is located on the right-hand side. These were super fancy and state of the art in the 1980s, but there is new and different equipment available today.

These items look very good. We have a robust painting program, but they do show from an interior basis some heavy rust. We have degradation and they are subject to water damage and intrusion.

Most of these switches are 30 to 40 years old, and they are approaching the end of their useful life. We do heavily maintain this equipment, but it is time to replace them.

This item seeks for professional engineering services to replace ten of the 40 units in the Epcot electrical system with industry standard dead-front switches and pad-mounted transformers. And those are pictured on the next slide.

So a little bit of a from/to. In the larger picture, you can see our vintage equipment. In the rear of the picture are HPL switches, and our unit

substation transformers. And then in the forefront of the picture, you can see a industry standard pad-mounted switch, and in the lower picture on the right-hand side, you can see a pad-mounted transformer.

So we did go out in February of this year for Letter of Interest for engineering services for the design of these replacements, and we received three bids. We are proposing approval to Chen Moore and Associates, a local firm in Maitland.

So today we are seeking Board approval of contract C006528 with Chen Moore and Associates for professional engineering services for replacement of high potential or HPL load-break switches on the Epcot distribution system in the amount of \$570,335.10, plus 10 percent contingency, for a total of \$627,368.61, and an RCES design and support services fee not to exceed \$200,000 for the design and bidding phases.

The design of this project will be funded through the fiscal year 2025 utility capital planned work fund. These are funds collected through the current year's rates. I do anticipate when we bring this back to the Board for the construction contract, the Board will be leveraging

existing bond funds for the construction part of this project, but we have plans in the current utility rates to fund the design in the fiscal '25 rate structure.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Great. Well, Chris, I will resist the urge to speak up in defense of things from the '80s, but I appreciate -- appreciate that. It is my understanding that the replacement -- sounds like the replacements will have a pretty long lead time, so appreciate you getting ahead of the ball with the load-break switches and the transformer replacements.

So before we get to a vote, I would like to ask the members if they have any -- any questions.

MS. ZIEGLER: No.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Okay. Then hearing none, is there a motion to approve item No. 8.3?

MS. ZIEGLER: Yes, move approval of item 8.3.

MR. AUNGST: Second.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: All those in favor, say aye.

THE BOARD: Aye.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Any opposed? Hearing none, let the record reflect the motion passes unanimously. Thank you.

Next, Chris will present to the Board item No. 8.4 on the agenda. The District seeks to approve the purchase of two, 69,000-volt substation transformers from Prolec GE Waukesha for \$3,493,186. Chris, why don't you -- why don't you go ahead?

MS. FERRARO: All right. I will try to be brief, but this is my favorite subject, so we're going to talk about the District's electric system. So just a little bit of a background, so that lovely picture is our point of interconnection with Tampa Electric Company. It's actually owned by Tampa Electric. Those are the famous Mickey ears on the southern side of our property.

That is one of five connections that the District has with the Florida electric grid.

Within the District's electric system, we have 28 miles of 69,000-volt transmission lines, half of which is overhead, and half is underground.

Connected to that 69,000-volt line, we have nine customer supplying substations with 15 power transformers that stepped the voltage down from 69,000 volts to 12,470 volts.

The typical service life for one of those transformers that stepped that voltage down from

69,000 to 12,000 volts is 30 years under standard operating conditions. We do an awesome job maintaining those units and monitoring their condition, so we have seen longer lives from those units.

And I will speak of some of my contemporaries now, Vice Chair. So the last transformers that were replaced in the District were at the Lake Buena Vista substation, which were about 50 years old. So I'll classify myself as vintage, as well --

MR. AUNGST: So ten more years of useful life.

MS. FERRARO: We did replace those transformers. We were very lucky at that time to have an opportunity to do that. One of the fortunate things that came to us during COVID, the property was less occupied, and we were able to do that work without impact.

So, at this time, we are keeping an eye on the transformers at the District's Epcot substation. They were installed in 1981. We do extensive testing on those transformers, internal and external inspections, but we do feel like they are approaching the end of their useful life and would like to get an order in now for their replacements.

The lead time for these units now is between 137 and 170 weeks. We would like to procure two. There are two identical transformers at Epcot. They each back each other up, so if we lose one transformer at the substation, there is a fully redundant in-service second transformer. We went out for three quotes for these transformers. The low responsive bidder that we have used before is Prolec GE -- and it's Waukesha. I had a briefing on that before the meeting.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: I did know it was Wisconsin. I did know it was Wisconsin, but, you know.

MS. FERRARO: Waukesha. The amount that we have been quoted is \$3,493,186. Just to give the Board a sense of price escalation, the units that we replaced at Lake Buena Vista substation we received in 2019, they were \$1.3 million. Just to give you a sense of the supply and demand forces in the market.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Oh, yeah.

MS. FERRARO: So, again, we are proposing, at this time, with the long lead time, looking to ensure this purchase with the use of the unrestricted reserve funds, and to secure some of

this toward the purchase, we do -- are required to put down 10 percent of the purchase price per the terms with the vendor of \$349,319.

We will also reserve an additional 10 percent. There is a mandatory cancelation clause. We don't expect to cancel, but we want the District to be assured that the funds are held. We are expecting delivery of these items in 2027. We will be coming back to the Board with the project for replacement of these. We'll be budgeting that full -- that full project work and planning that looking forward to '27 and '28, likely using available bond funds at the time, but we'd like to go ahead and place this order now.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Great. Yeah, I mean, look, I think there was an audible -- does that conclude? Sorry.

MS. FERRARO: Yes.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Okay. I mean, I think there was a little bit of an audible response to the lead time and the numbers, and I think -- I can understand that response. Anybody familiar with, you know, the procurement of transformers in this current environment, and the last few years, you know, the longer lead times, and sharply higher

costs are -- they're not surprising. That's consistent with certainly my experience, and I think that's just the new reality we live in.

So I appreciate your efforts to get out -- get out in front of this. And, obviously, very thorough -- very thorough presentation on that.

So any particular challenges or concerns related to this project that you've otherwise stated? I mean...

MS. FERRARO: We always have a continuity of service concern, right, when we take our system out of configuration to replace one. We'll do a lot of studying to make sure that as we move load around the system that we maintain. We usually have at least two additional sources, sometimes three, in the electric system. That's why we don't lose power during hurricanes, but we'll be -- there will be a lot of complexity with the replacement, but we've done it before, and we'll do it again.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Great, thanks. Thanks, Chris. With that, any questions, or, if not, is there a motion to approve the purchase of the two, 69,000-volt substation transformers from Prolec GE Waukesha in the amount of \$3,493,186.

MR. AUNGST: Move to approve agenda item 8.4.

MS. ZIEGLER: Second.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: All those in favor, say aye.

THE BOARD: Aye.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Any opposed? Hearing none, let the record reflect that that motion passes unanimously.

And now on to agenda item 8.5, the last item in our agenda. Chris to present, the District will seek approval to award three-year continuing service contracts to the top ranked and selected firms for electrical, hydrology/wastewater, and mechanical engineering services.

Chris, I understand several of the firms qualified as Buy Local vendors, which I'm excited to hear about. I appreciate the work of the District procurement team and your team at RCES that you put in procuring those services locally. It's very meaningful to me, and I know the rest of the Board, so please -- please continue.

MS. FERRARO: Wonderful. So just a little bit of background, and I, too, echo really my gratitude to Tiffany and her whole team. This was a significant lift. It starts us into the process of the CCNA process required by Florida statute.

We're really looking to get well-qualified vendors, and then trying to establish a number of firms that we can work with to provide outstanding services to the District.

So we did issue three Letters of Interest in July of this year for engineering services for electric, hydrology and wastewater, and mechanical engineering services. We had a great response, as you mentioned, from a number of local firms. There were 49 firms that responded, and 27 firms that were selected. A really significant lift.

We were able to get six consultants that were recommending continuing service contracts for electrical, 12 for hydrology/wastewater and civil, and nine consultants for mechanical engineering.

Our firms are listed here, and you can see really how well we did with great local talent. And I should tell you that these are the A students. As a District, we developed a scoring criteria partnering with procurement and contracting, and these are the folks that are at 90 out of 100. These are really well-suited to do work with the District, as we -- we know we're a little bit unique, but looking forward to the relationships with these teams.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Excellent. Yeah.

MS. FERRARO: Moving forward, how we'll use these continuing services contracts, we'll issue authorized task work order for each of the work scopes. We will document what help we're looking for from the consultant, pick the folks that are qualified, and then look toward what's their specialty, workload and capability for that project. We'll also look to take a fair and balanced approach spreading this work among those well-qualified firms based on their availability and the expertise, and that will be at the discretion of the District, but, again, following the Florida statute for the CCNA process.

These are some great pictures of all the nifty things we're going to do together from an engineering services procurement. We have some switch gear, some of our large chillers, piping systems, potable water supplies and then piping and waste way work, and that concludes my presentation.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Chris, thank you very much. I appreciate your time and effort in today's presentations, Chris. You know, you make -- you make cooling towers cool, so thank you for that. Well done.

I think so often -- well, before the hurricane, I know that Tanya and I have spoken before, and I have said this before, but our emergency response plan is exceptional, and it really, again, is a testament to the caliber of work that makes up this District.

I know we talk about that a lot, but we've had the privilege of working in other places in the state, and it really is exceptional. And I think it's evidenced as to how you guys were able to sustain that, but the part that I think is oftentimes missed is that while you're here serving, your homes may or may not have been impacted or your family, and so often that -- we live and work in this hospitality space and don't skip a beat, and I think that you guys take that to heart. And I think it's unique you got to really experience it, I didn't realize that.

So -- but, again, thank you to all of you for the hard work. I know it's been a heck of a month, but onward and upward, but I just wanted to, again, appreciate that.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Amen. Thank you. Very well said. Supervisor Aungst?

I think that's a perfect note upon which to end. I -- as we reach the end of our meeting time, I guess I'll just state for -- between now and our next meeting scheduled for -- gosh, when is our next -- it's the end of November.

MS. KOPELOUSOS: November 20th.

VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: So between now and then, you-all may be aware there's an election happening. I hope that all those in the District who are legally qualified and registered to vote take the opportunity to do so. I think we can be very proud in the State of Florida. We have -- you know, our election integrity is beyond reproach. You can be confident that your vote will count when it should be counted, and that the results are going to be reached in a timely manner on -- on election night, as it should be, as George Washington would have wanted.

So with that, good luck. I hope you-all will vote on election day, and I look forward to having that -- having that behind us, as well. So with that, if there's no further business to discuss, I adjourn -- I will -- well, I will make a motion to

adjourn the meeting. Is there a second? MS. ZIEGLER: Second. VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: All those in favor. THE BOARD: Aye. VICE CHAIR BARAKAT: Hearing none, let the record reflect the -- that motion to adjourn the meeting has passed unanimously; therefore, I adjourn the October 23rd meeting of the Central Florida Tourism Oversight District Board at 11:23 in the morning. Thank you-all. (The meeting adjourned at 11:23 a.m.)
